**Commander's Column.** I hope all of you have taken the time to send in your Regimental and Company dues to Dave Wilkens and your check for the Saint David's Day Dinner to Rob Price. If not, what are you waiting for? It's almost March, and the campaigning season will be on us before you know it. Speaking of knowing things, do you know where your uniform and equipment are and what their condition is? Things have a habit of migrating around in my basement, so if you're like me, now would be a good time to check on your uniform and equipment to make sure that you know where they are and that everything is in good condition.

**The Fusilier.** The Fusilier is the official Regimental newsletter, which lets you know which events you have been authorized to attend as a member of the Regiment. Are you receiving your copy of The Fusilier? If you paid your dues for last year, you certainly should be. So, if, for some reason, you did not receive The Fusilier earlier this year, let me know so I can get that corrected. Of course, after March 1<sup>st</sup>, you're going to need to have paid your dues to continue to receive it.

**Saint David's Day.** As noted in The Fusilier, the Regimental Saint David's Day Dinner will be held on Saturday, March 3, 2012, in Gettysburg, PA, at the Dobbins Tavern. I hope all of you will take this opportunity to attend this very important Regimental celebration. The cost of the dinner is \$35.00 per person, which amount should be sent in a check made payable to "RWFA" to Rob Price, 79 Everett Avenue, West Hartford, CT 06107. The entrée choices are Baked Chicken Hunter Style, Broiled Filet of Salmon, and Prime Rib of Beef. All of the details are in The Fusilier, so take a look there for additional information. Many thanks to Serjeant Shane Reilly in getting the dinner set up with the Dobbins Tavern. See you in Gettysburg on March 3rd!

**Company Dues.** Company dues this year are \$5.00. Please include them with your check covering Regimental dues for 2012, which are covered in the next paragraph.

**Regimental Dues.** As everyone should be aware from reading The Fusilier, there has been a slight change in how to pay your Regimental dues for 2012. Regimental dues are \$20 if paid before March 1st. If you pay after March 1st but before April 15<sup>th</sup>, you will have to pay \$25, which is the normal annual amount. And, Regimental dues paid after April 15th will be \$30. BAR dues are still \$25. Please send your checks now - do not wait until the end of February to get out your checkbook. You run the very real risk that your dues will get in late and you will owe the

Regiment another \$5. So, get out that checkbook, find a pen, and write a check now for \$25.00. That covers your Regimental and Company dues. Get an envelope and address it to our Company Clerk, **David Wilkins, 6605 Sutton Drive, North Olmsted, OH 44070**. Put a stamp on it (remember, postal rates have gone up, so a first class stamp costs 45 cents) and put it in the closest mailbox. You're done. What could be easier? But don't put it off – March 1<sup>st</sup> will be here before you know it. Envelopes post-marked after March 1<sup>st</sup> will be late and you will have to pay the difference.

As previously noted in The Fusilier, Regimental dues are \$20 if you pay them before March 1, 2012. That's a discounted rate! After March 1<sup>st</sup>, they go up in \$5.00 increments. So, if you don't want to be paying more than you need to pay, send in your dues immediately. This year, again, we are asking that you pay \$5.00 for Grenadier Company dues in addition to the \$20.00 for Regimental dues we're not going to make you pay more in company dues if you're late, but you still need to send in your dues as soon as you can. Send your check or money order, along with the payment stub below, in a U.S. Postal Service to Dave. Since this is being sent out by email, you'll have to print this out on your own and supply your own envelope. Please get this in the mail to Dave well before March 1<sup>st</sup>, Saint David's Day, so we can make sure you continue to receive The Fusilier and The Blurb, as well as participate in some great events.
