Happy Minden Day to all!

"Today is the 260th anniversary of the Battle of Minden on August 1, 1759. The Battle of Minden was fought between Anglo-German troops and those of France during the Seven Years' War. It is celebrated by regiments that fought at the battle by the wearing of roses in their headdress. Prior to the battle advancing British infantry and artillery picked roses from German gardens and displayed them on their uniforms. In memory of this, men of all ranks, in each of the Minden regiments, wear roses in their caps on August 1 to commemorate the battle. Those celebrating today will be:

12th of Foot (Suffolk Regiment), now part of The Royal Anglian Regiment 20th Foot (Lancashire Fusiliers), now part of the Royal Regiment of Fusiliers 23rd Foot (Royal Welch Fusiliers), now the 1st Battalion, The Royal Welsh (Royal Welch Fusiliers)

25th Foot (King's Own Scottish Borderers), now The Royal Scots Borderers (1st Battalion The Royal Regiment of Scotland)

37th Foot (Royal Hampshire Regiment), now part of the Princess of Wales's Royal Regiment

51st Foot (King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry), now part of The Rifles"
