I hope that you all the opportunity to hoist a glass in honor of St. David and our regiment.

There has some been activity on the event schedule since the last edition of the Fusilier. The event at Fort Loudon (Pennsylvania) scheduled for the end of May was cancelled per the British Brigade. I added another May event, Army Heritage Days (15-17 May), in Carlisle. This is a timeline event with units from multiple time periods. I work at the site as both a Department of the Army civilian contractor and am assigned there as USAR officer. The organizational leadership may allow me to wear the royal uniform instead of my 21st century, military earth tones. The location includes a full-size replica of Yorktown's Redoubt #10, which is typically where the 23st is placed during the event. Its central location (three hours from New York City and Pittsburgh, two-and-a-half from Philadelphia, and two from Baltimore and Washington) makes it an ideal spot to consolidate some of our Eastern units. Camping is available on-site and there are a number of hotels within a 15-minute drive of the event. Please contact me if you're interested in attending.
