Turn right onto W Street Rd/PA-926.WEST CHESTER LUKOIL is on the corner. Turn left onto S New St. S. New St is 0.4 miles past Bridlewood Blvd. If you reach Lake Dr. you've gone about 0.2 miles too far. 1360 S NEW ST. the destination is 0.1 miles past Revere Rd

If you're in PA you can follow 422 E to its merge with 202S in King of Prussia.

This is a local event for me so I have an idea what the weather will be. Although it's a long range prediction, weather for the weekend is supposed to be a high in the upper 60's and a low in the upper 40's at night. Pretty darn near perfect weather.
